LONG TITLE

A Statute to accept certain territory from the Diocese of Perth.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS it is considered desirable and expedient that the boundary between the Diocese of North West Australia and the Diocese of Perth be varied by the acceptance by the Diocese of North West Australia of territory surrendered to it by the Diocese of Perth

The Synod of the Diocese of North West Australia resolves as follows.

Chapter 1 – Preliminary

NAME

This is the *Acceptance of Territory from the Diocese of Perth Statute 1998*.

Chapter 2 – Scope of the Statute

1. Subject to this Statute, the transfer from the Diocese of Perth of those parts of the territory of the Diocese of Perth identified as A and B and comprised within the boundaries respectively defined in the Schedule of this Statute shall be accepted by the Diocese of North West Australia.
2. The boundary between the Diocese of North West Australia and the Diocese of Perth as varied by this Statute shall be defined on a map or plan which shall be prepared in duplicate and certified by the Archbishop of Perth and the Bishop of North West Australia and thereafter one copy shall be lodged with the Diocese of North West Australia and the other with the Diocese of Perth and each certified copy shall be

conclusive evidence of the boundary between the Diocese of North West Australia and the Diocese of Perth as varied by this Statute.

3. The acceptance of territory for which provision is made by this Statute shall take effect when:
- (a) the Diocese of Perth having by Statute provided for the surrender of territory;
 - (b) the surrender and acceptance is ratified by or under a Canon of the General Synod of the Anglican Church of Australia.

Chapter 3 – Regulations & Related Legislation

REGULATIONS

Regulation making power

The Diocesan Council may from time to time make, amend or repeal regulations (e.g. policies and procedures) not inconsistent with the provisions of this Statute providing for records arising out of or incidental to the operation of this Statute and for all or any of the purposes, whether general or to meet particular cases, which may be convenient for the administration of this Statute or which may be necessary or expedient to carry out the overriding purposes of this Statute.

Chapter 4 – General

RESPONSIBILITIES

Review

The Diocesan Council will review the operation of this Statute on or before six years after its commencement.

Records management

The Registry maintains all records relevant to administering this Statute using its recordkeeping system.

Bounded on the north by the 29th parallel of south latitude
Bounded on the east by the meridian of 115 degrees 33 minutes 45 seconds of east longitude
Bounded on the south by the parallel of 29 degrees 21 minutes 25 seconds of south latitude
Bounded on the west by the meridian of 115 degrees 15 minutes east longitude.

SCHEDULE B

Bounded on the north by the 26th parallel of south latitude
Bounded on the east by the boundary of Western Australia
Bounded on the south by the 29th parallel of south latitude
Bounded on the west by the 120th meridian of east longitude.
